Prof. H.R. Shan, Controller of Examinations and Sh. B.L. Bhat, Asstt. Registrar attended the meeting as special invitees.

8. Prof. Gupta placed the matter regarding internal evaluation of MOOCS through SWAYAM website instead of external evaluation for M.Ed. and M.A. (Education) programmes Semester – III for the session 2020-22 and 2021-23.

**The members after threadbare discussion on the matter concluded that many universities had faced this problem and it was resolved with the approval of their respective academic councils that the internal evaluation of the MOOCs programme be done where the testing by external agency is delayed. This has been done to ensure that results are declared on time. Therefore, the matter be referred to the Academic Council for consideration and approval.**
