### NEED FOR CREATING KNOWLEDGE BASED SOCIETY IN J&K PROF. AMITABH MATTOO

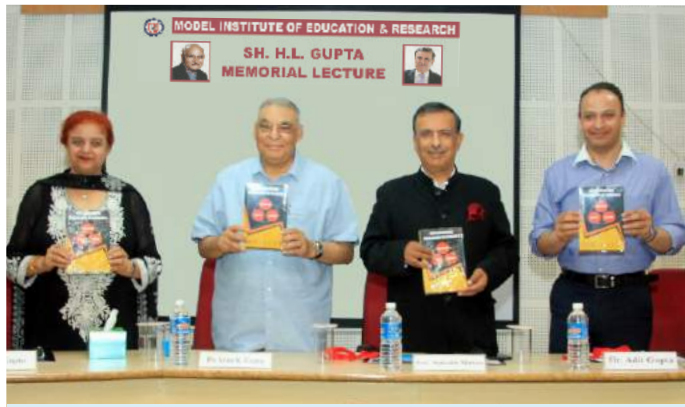

## INVITED LECTURE |

### EMERGING TRENDS IN EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGY

An extension lecture on the theme “Emerging Trends in Educational Technology: Collaboration and Integration” was delivered on February 17, 2018. by Dr. J.N. Baliya, Assistant Professor, Central University of Jammu. In his address, Dr. Baliya said that educational technology facilitates learning and improves the performance of students by creating, using and managing appropriate technological processes and resources which results in the improvement and enhancement of the quality of the education. He discussed different uses of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in the aspects of teaching-learning process such as teaching, evaluation, grading system, feedback and remedial programmes. He also deliberated on various tools of ICT such as online discussion groups and forums, blogs, instant messaging, video-conferencing, open resources etc. which can develop collaborative learning environment in the educational scenario.





# INNOVATIVE METHODOLOGIES OF TEACHING



In order to train the faculty in innovative methodologies of teaching, the college organized a series of in-house workshops on constructivist, cooperative and collaborative teaching wherein college teacher educators were shown videos on all the above mentioned approaches followed by hands-on experience on these methodologies by giving demonstration of model lessons by Dr. Rohnika Sharma, HoD, UG Department and Dr. Annie Koul, IQAC Incharge.

This was followed by one day workshop on the theme “Teaching Through Constructivist Approach” for B Ed students of all Colleges of Education. Dr Jyoti Parihar, Associate Professor, Government College of Education, Jammu, was the chief resource person. The workshop aimed to enhance the understanding of constructivist approach of teaching as a part of the B Ed curriculum and teaching practice techniques. Student and faculty representatives from nine Colleges of Education participated in the workshop.

Dr Parihar explained the concept of constructivism which includes the idea that knowledge is constructed by the learner himself primarily in a group based situation on previous knowledge and leading to creation of new knowledge based on experiences. She deliberated comprehensively on the different steps of the 5'E' model such as engage, explore, explain, elaborate and evaluate by providing examples and the format of the lesson plans. Lessons in different teaching subjects namely science, math, social studies and languages were

demonstrated by the pupil teachers of both the Govt. College of Education and MIER College. Faculty and students were asked to clarify their doubts and give suggestions to improve the lesson plans. Certificates were also distributed among the participants.

The college is now in the process of publishing a booklet “Constructivist Approach to Teaching and Learning” A manual for practicing teachers which will be accessible to faculty and students of all Colleges of Education





## CENTER FOR EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH

### RESEARCH ANNUAL AWARDS



MIER College of Education organized the Research Awards for the year 2018 for felicitating its faculty members with cash awards along with certificates on April 5, 2018. Prof Rajni Kant, Director Colleges Development Council, University of Jammu was the Chief Guest on the occasion.



The faculty published 44 research papers in national and international journals, conference proceedings and book chapters. They also presented 54 papers in national and international seminars and conferences showcasing their research acumen in the field of education.

The resource person was Dr. Monika Bajaj, Assistant Professor, MIER College of Education for the research colloquium. She dwelt on her Ph.D. thesis topic "Learning Environments of Technology Supported Classrooms in Teacher Education Programme" on November 23, 2017.

She highlighted that technology supported classroom environment helps in creating healthy teacher student interpersonal relationships and promote positive behaviour besides better learning outcome. The results of the study indicated that the students saw their teacher educators as good leaders and rated them as helpful, friendly, and understanding in addition to being democratic in a technology supported environment.

An orientation on "How to Write a Research Paper" was organised for the faculty of the college on November 30, 2017. Dr. Adit Gupta was the resource person for the programme. - Semester wise Collection of Feedback

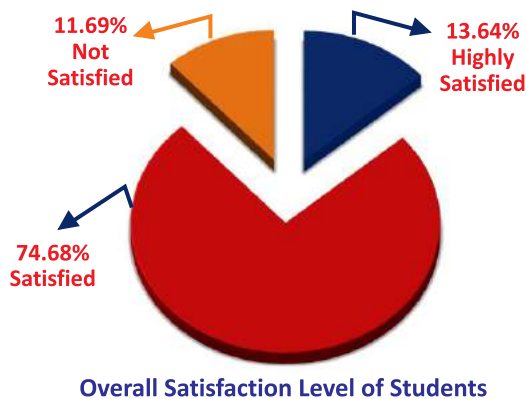


Based on 360 degree feedback and the training needs analysis, following training and orientation programmes were organized for teaching and non teaching staff :

## COLLEGES VISIT INCLUSIVE SET UP



B.Ed. Special Education Department runs and maintains a special school in an inclusive setup as per RCI norms since 2014. As part of the new two year B.Ed. curriculum, all B.Ed. students are required to visit a special/inclusive school for sessional work to understand how special children are to be taught and coached through special methodologies like differential instructions and assessment. In this context more than 200 teacher trainees

from 6 different colleges of education along with their faculty visited our inclusive school last year which is one of its kind of school set up in the State of J&K.

During these visits, students are given orientation about the concept of Inclusive Education through documentaries and demonstration on different methodologies used by special educators to teach children

with special needs. They also visit the rehabilitation centre to see different equipment used for physiotherapy and occupational therapy to rehabilitate the children with special needs. The department also provides vocational training support for adolescent special children to help them enter the world of work and improve their quality of life.

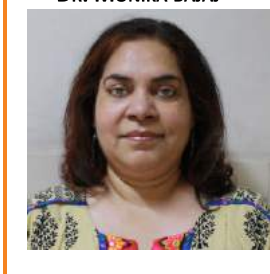
