



### Q1 Programme Enrolled




## Q2 Gender


# Q3 How did you come to know about MIER College of Education?

### Q4 Why did you choose MIER College of Education to pursue this course?





### Q5 Online Admission through Website





# Q6 Interaction with Assistant Registrar (AR) Admissions



# Q7 Interaction with Fee Counter In- Charge





### Q9 Interaction with Security Staff


