



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REPORT ON ONLINE COLLAGE MAKING COMPETITION



The Judges of the event were Dr. Rohnika Sharma (HOD, UG Department) and Ms.Ruchi Sharma (IQAC)



REPORT OF THE GUEST LECTURE ON 'NEW EDUCATION POLICY 2020- THE FUTURE OF TEACHER EDUCATION' ON 25TH MARCH, 2021

A guest lecture was organized by the Co-Curricular Committee of MIER College on the theme 'New Education Policy 2020-The Future of Teacher Education'. Prof. Rajeev Rattan Sharma, Head PG Department of Education, University of Jammu was the Resource person. Dr. Adit Gupta, Principal MIER College of Education chaired the lecture. Dr Mool Raj Sharma HoD PG Department, Dr. Rohinka Sharma HoD UG Department along with the faculty members and the students of both PG and UG Department of semester first attended the event.


Dr. Adit Gupta, Principal MIER College of Education extended a warm welcome to the resource person and the audience. He introduced him as an expert in Teacher Education, Comparative Education, Sociological and Philosophical Perspectives on Education. He further said that Prof. Rattan is a distinguished researcher and a teacher educator, who has published his work and presented both at national and international conferences. Additionally, he has guided many research scholars at MPhil and PhD levels and undertook state and nation level projects in addition to organizing workshops and conferences. He has held many administrative positions at different levels and has many accolades to his credit.

Speaking on the occasion, Prof. Rajeev Rattan Sharma emphasized on the need of change and transformation of education such as to achieve the goals of sustainable development, improve learning outcomes and cognitive skills of students, minimize fragmentation in higher education and rigid separation of different disciplines. He also comprehensively explained the relevance of bringing this change and transformation in education. Prof Rattan provided an overview of the policy and specificly elaborated on teacher and teacher education be it the shifting of teacher education from school education arena to higher education or the structure of teacher education or the preparation of teachers for different levels namely foundational, middle and secondary. He also deliberated on the transformation of teacher preparation institutes into multidisciplinary institutes, curriculum for teacher preparation, mentorship and different programs from one-year to four-years. Prof Rattan highlighted various future challenges such as implementing single national test by NTA, accreditation, public-private partnership, etc.

NATIONAL EDUCATION DAY CELEBRATED AT MIER COLLEGE OF EDUCATION

An online panel discussion was organized by the Co-curricular Committee of MIER College to celebrate National Education Day. The theme of the symposium was New Education Policy 2020- A paradigm Shift for Higher Education.


The eminent panelists were Dr. Adit Gupta, Principal MIER College of Education, Dr. Vikram Gulati Principal Shivalik College of Education was the Chief Guest., Dr. N.R. Sharma, Dean Academic MIER College, Dr Mool Raj Sharma HoD PG Department and Dr. Rohinka Sharma HoD UG Department MIER College. The faculty members and the students of both PG and UG Department of MIER College attended the event.

Mrs. Komal Sharma, Convener Cocurricular Committee extended a warm welcome to the panelists and the audience. She introduced the panelist to the audience highlighting their experience and achievements in the field of education. Mrs. Sharma emphasized that every year November 11 is celebrated as education day to commemorate the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first education minister of independent India.

Opening up the discussion, Dr. Adit Gupta emphasized that the National Education Policy 2020 has been introduced after 30 years to complement the process and vision of creating quality institutions, a culture of innovation and research, and a highly skilled workforce. This policy will also help to transform the educational institutions in India to meet the international standards and attract foreign students. Following which Prof. N.R. Sharma highlighted that as per NEP 2020, the rigid separations between subjects' stream will be done away with and students will have the liberty to choose subjects they would like to study across streams. This will also have impact on teacher preparation programs and teacher education. He also said this policy focuses on the development of human values. Dr. Vikram Gulati discussed that this policy stresses on the autonomy of teachers and educational institutions in addition to advocating flexibility in the curriculum, teaching pedagogies and assessment. He said the focus of the policy is on creating multidisciplinary campuses and collaboration with foreign universities. Dr. Moolraj Sharma focused on processes and assigned roles of the teachers and teacher educators to make India as global knowledge and research superpower. Dr. Rohnika Sharma deliberated on equity and inclusion in higher education as envisaged by this policy and highlighted that steps like providing scholarship and financial incentives, modifying admission process and curriculum to

meet needs to the students and increase their employability. This was followed by an interactive session where the students and the faculty members





NSS Day Celebration on 28th September, 2020
