
DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS: An effort was made to receive feedback from the students of the college. For this purpose, an online feedback form was created and shared with the students of SOE, IV semester (2021-2023 batch) and SOSSH IV semester (2021-24) through Performance Insight-360 (PI-360), Quality Analytics Framework. In order to arrive at comprehensive results, a useful statistical tool like percentage has been used. For effective presentation of the data, tables and graphs have been used. Questions were based on a 5-point Likert scale where: 1: Strongly agree, 2: Agree, 3: Neutral, 4: Disagree and 5: Strongly disagree.


Major Observations/Suggestions:

- Duration of examination of 2 credit course should be increased as students find it difficult to complete the exam in 2 hours.
- More field trips should be organised that are directly related to the topics that the students are learning in order to make meaningful connections between theory and practice.
- Teaching practice should be conducted in different schools. Exposure should be provided to students of different teaching environments, such as different grade levels, different subject areas, and different types of schools.
- The syllabus of the pedagogy of English should be revised as it is too lengthy. Additionally, there is a repetition of topics in some courses which should be reviewed in the light of the entire programme of teacher education.

Major Observations/Suggestions-


- The curriculum should be reviewed to check the repetition of topics and align it with the latest trends in higher education.


- The curriculum should be enriched with the latest research in the field of intellectual disability education.

B. Descriptive Feedback

40% of the students agreed and 8% of the students strongly agreed that the experiences gained from the curriculum are enriching. 52% of the responses were neutral. The responses received from the students highlighted that overall the curriculum is need-based, interesting to study and provides the students with opportunities to learn about different areas of psychology. Some of the major suggestions for improvement are given below:

Major Observations/Suggestions -

- A needs assessment should be conducted to identify the skills and knowledge that students need to learn.
- There is a lack of applied practical exposure. Field/educational trips should be organised. Industry exposure should be provided to directly link topics that students are learning.
- Teachers should include more interactive lectures and use different teaching methodologies to increase the student's interest.
- Students should be guided by teachers to search course books and topics in the prescribed books for the programme.

Follow-Up Action:

The analysis shall be submitted to the Principal. A meeting shall be convened by the Principal to discuss the feedback and an action taken report of the feedback shall be prepared.

Action Taken Report

A meeting was held by the Principal with the HoDs of SOE and SOSSH, Deputy HoD SOE, COE, Programme Coordinators, SOSSH and the IQAC team to discuss the major observations of the feedback and the suggestions given the by the students. The following action taken report has been prepared on the basis of the decisions taken in the meeting:

Programme-B.Ed.

No change shall be made in the duration of the examination because the time has been fixed as per the setting of the question paper and the prescribed word limit as per the approved curriculum. More tests shall be conducted in the class to give the students adequate practice so they can adhere to the time and word limit.
2.	More field trips should be organised that are directly related to the topics that the students are learning in order to make meaningful connections between theory and practice.	 It was decided to increase the number of field trips to preschools, local elementary schools and high schools. These trips shall be incorporated into the academic calendar of the SoE as it would help them better understand the principles of education and how to apply them in their teaching practice. It would also help them to make connections between what they are learning in the classroom and the real world.
3.	Teaching practice should be conducted in different schools.	 Students shall be sent to both CBSE schools and J&K Board schools for teaching practice. Since the students have to deliver two lessons as per their teaching subjects, they shall teach one at the elementary/middle level and the other one at the secondary level. Exposure shall thereby be provided to students of different teaching environments, grade levels, subject areas, and types of schools. Contact shall be made with the schools for the smooth conduct of teaching practice

- 4. The syllabus of pedagogy of English should be revised as it is too lengthy. Additionally, there is repetition of topics in some courses which should be reviewed in the light of the entire programme of teacher education.
- The academic committee of the SoE shall review the curriculum for making necessary changes wherever required. A report of the same shall be submitted to the Principal for final approval and implementation.
