Introduction

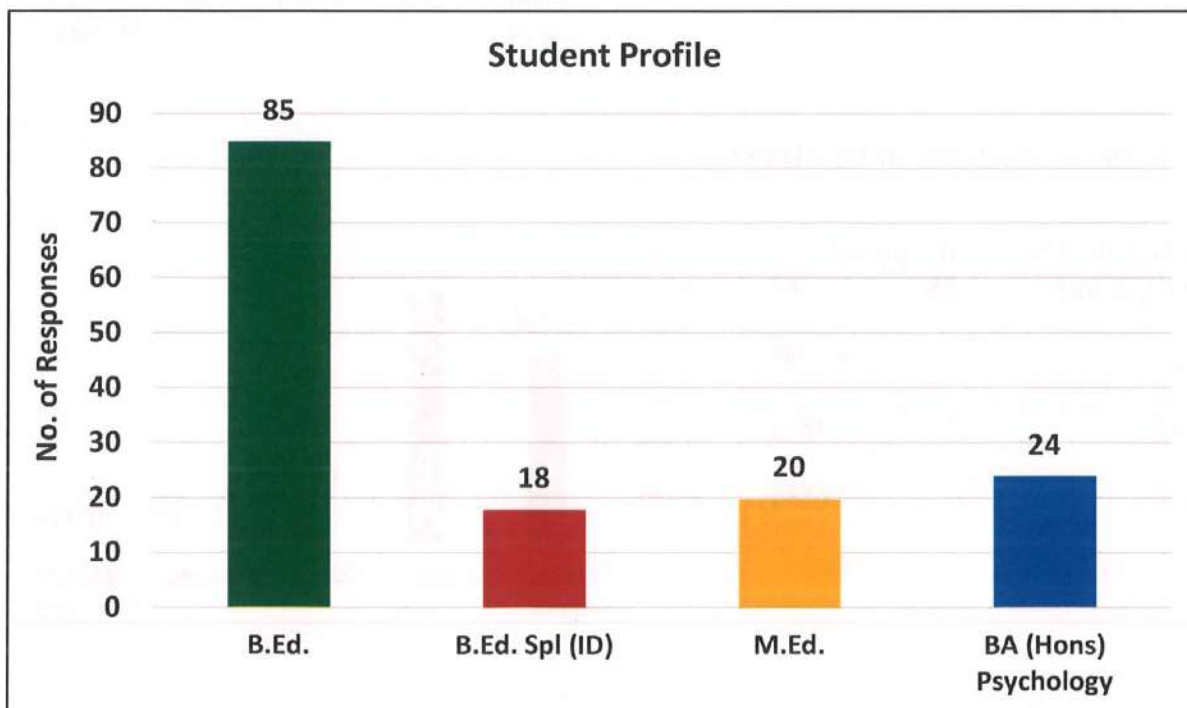
The IQAC conducted the Student Satisfaction Survey for the students of SOE and SOSSH. For this purpose, an online feedback form was created and shared with the students of SOE, semester IV (2021-2023) and SOSSH, semester IV (2021-24) through the Performance Insight-360 (PI-360), Quality Analytics Framework. 147 out of 154 students responded to the survey.

The questionnaire was designed to gather students' responses their overall experience, the quality of teaching and assessments, various initiatives of the college, campus facilities and services. Student responses will provide the College with valuable insights and guide it to serve and improve the educational experiences of current and future students.

To arrive at comprehensive results, a useful statistical tool like percentage has been used. For the effective presentation of the data tables and graphs have been used. Questions were based on a 5-point Likert scale- 1. Strongly agree 2. Agree 3. Neutral 4. Disagree 5. Strongly disagree.

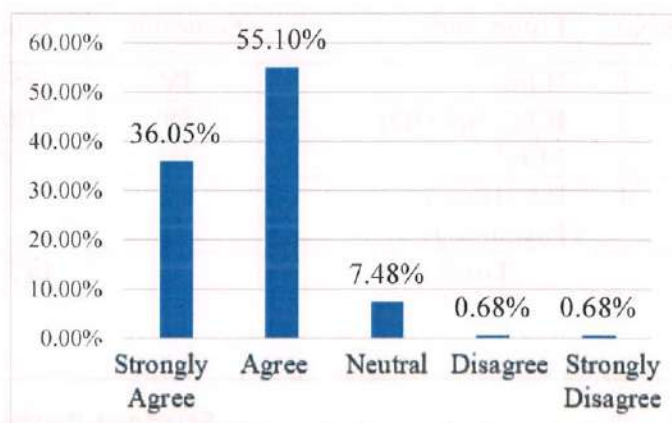

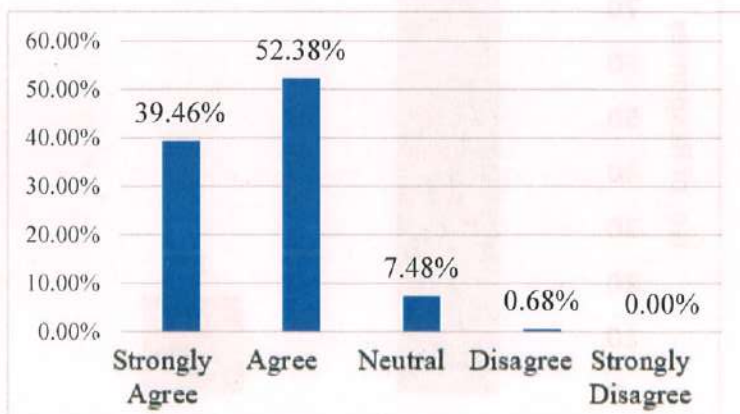

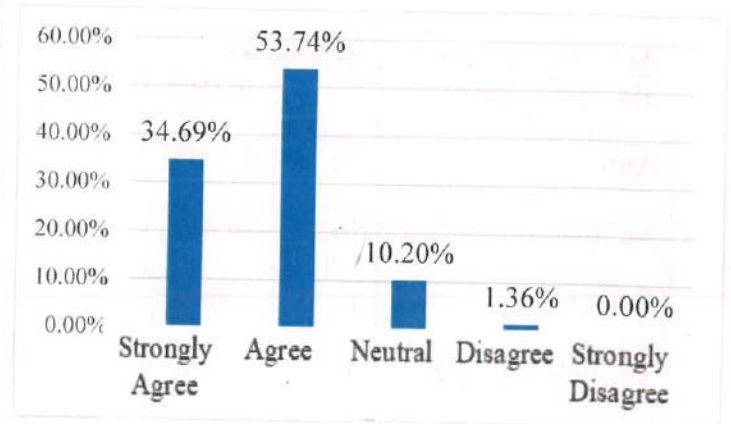

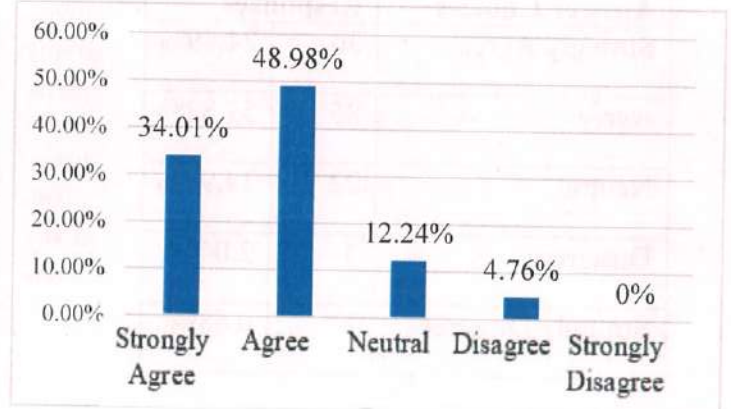

6. The method of teaching of the teachers is effective

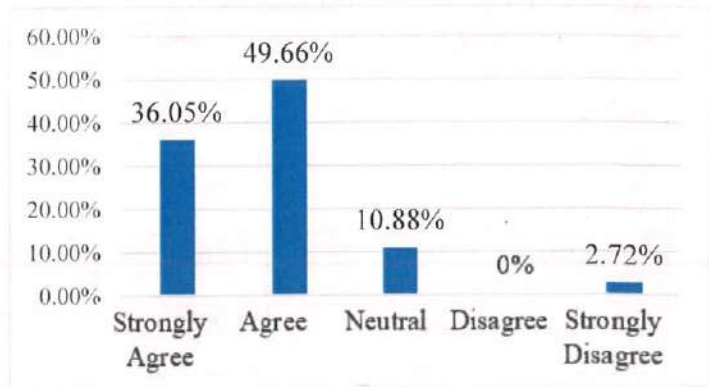

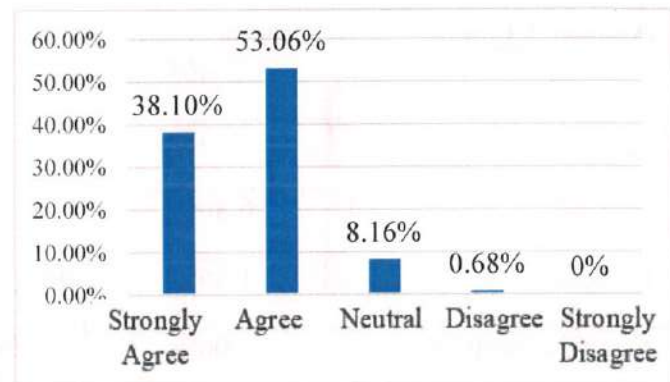

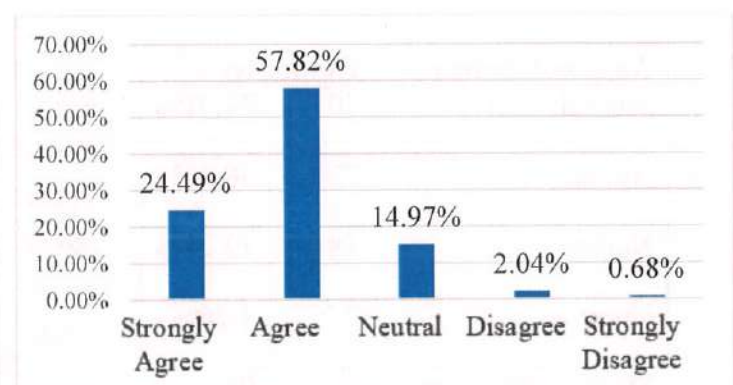

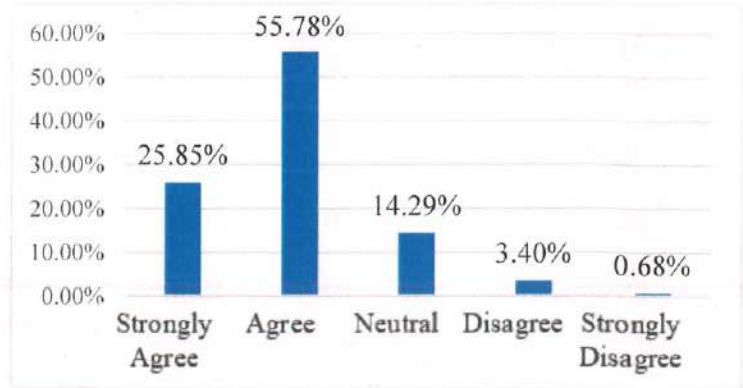

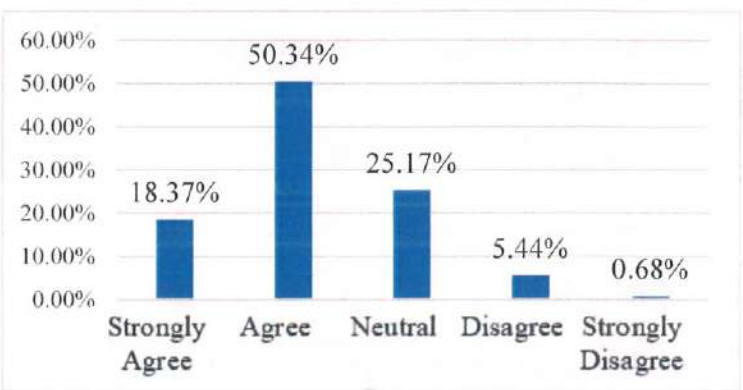

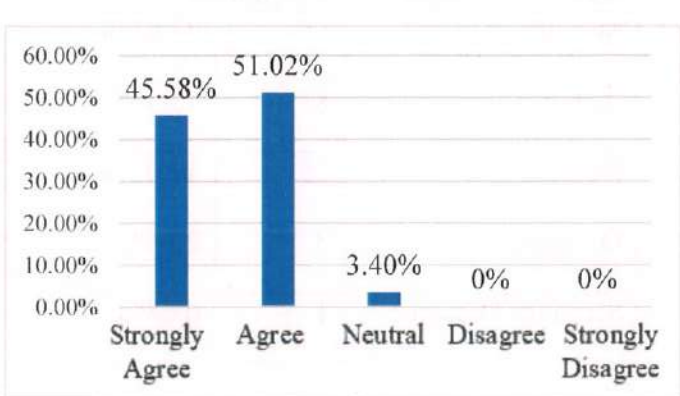

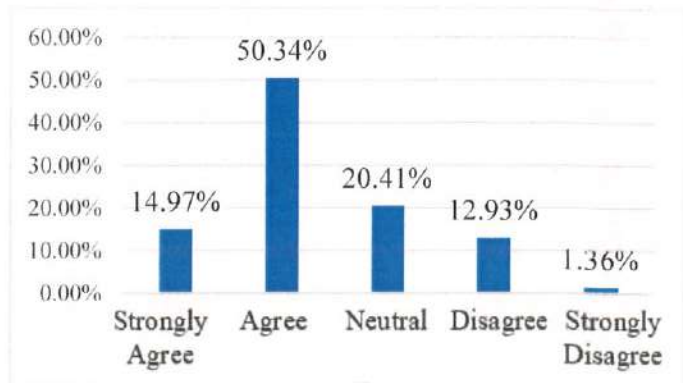

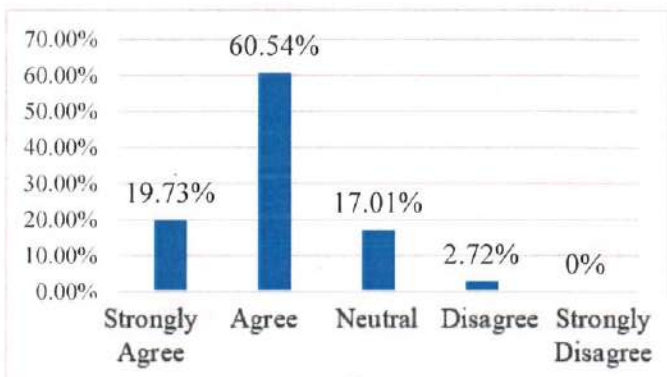
13. The attendance of the students in my class is good

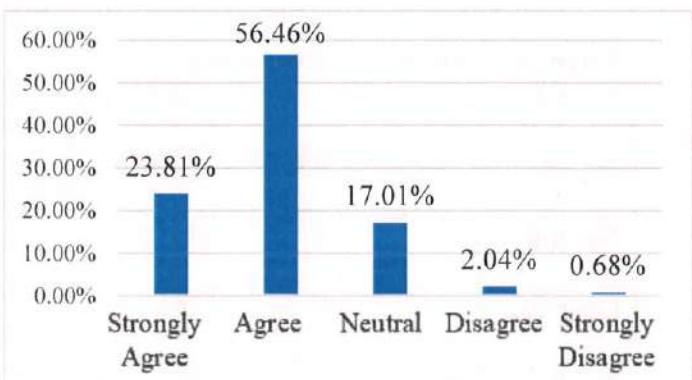

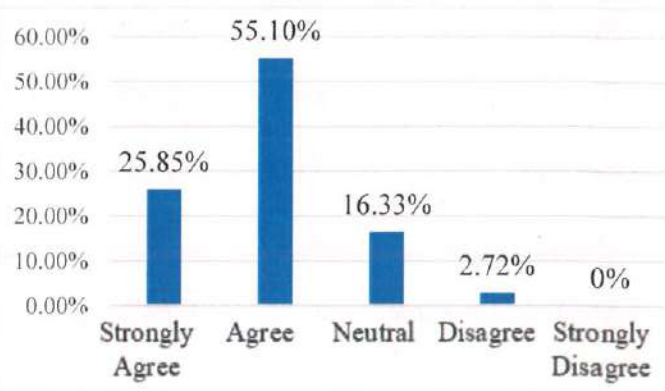

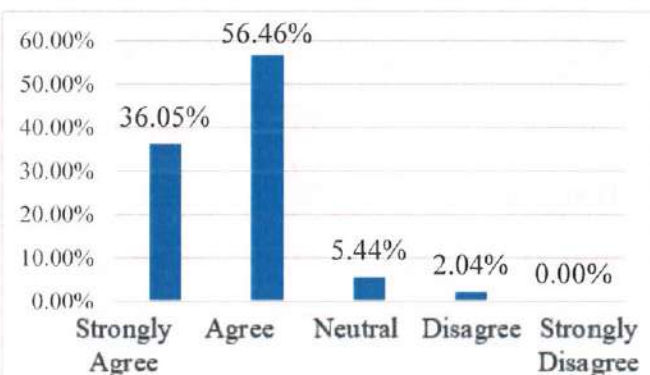

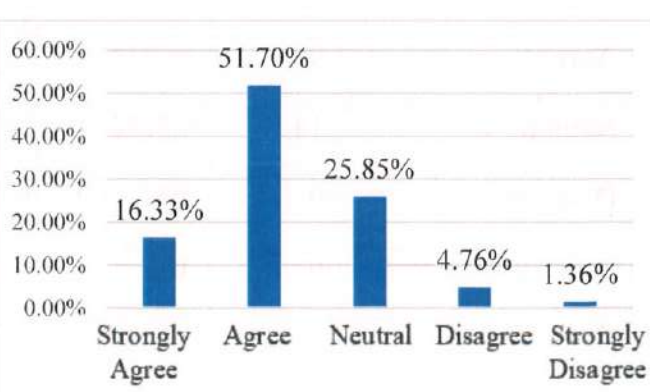

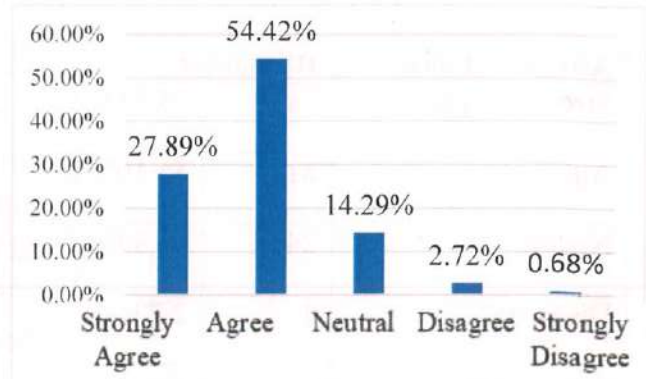

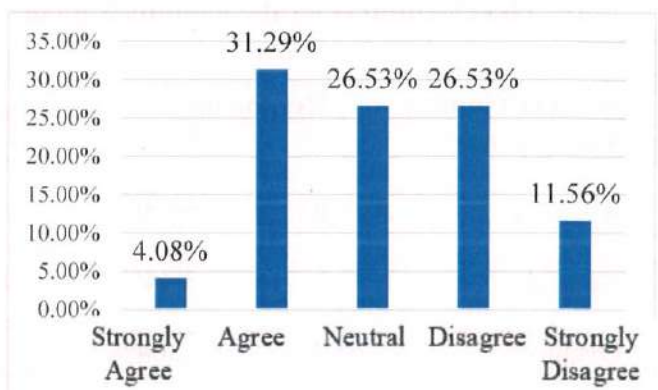

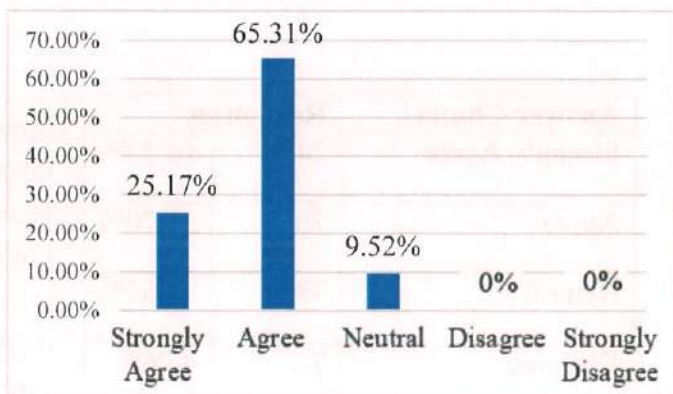

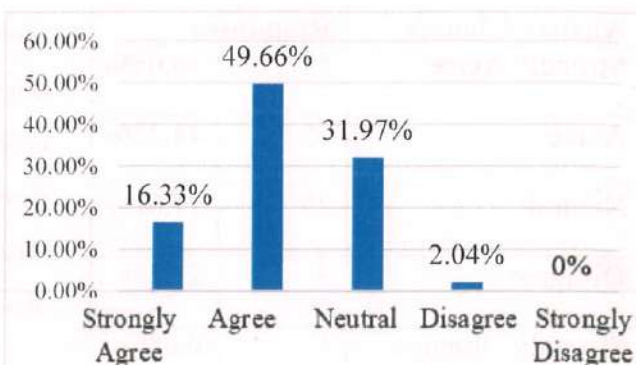

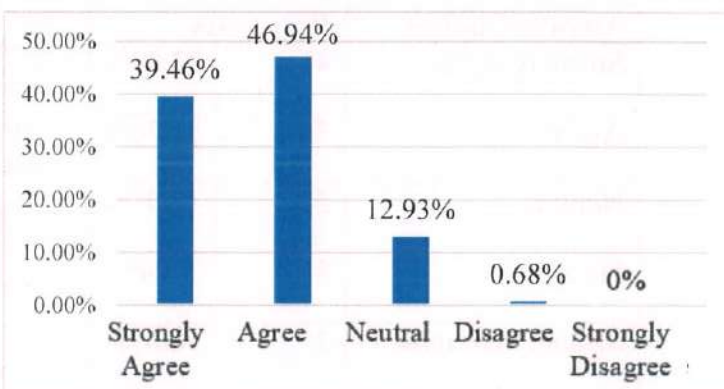
22. I take part in curricular activities organised in the college

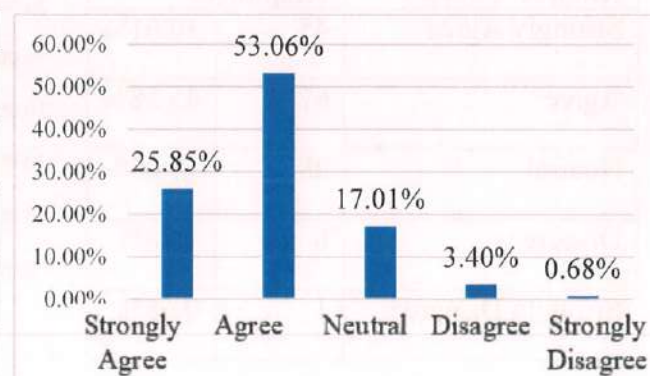

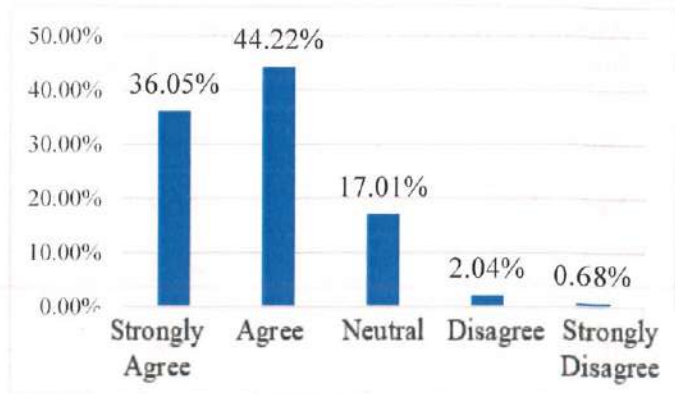

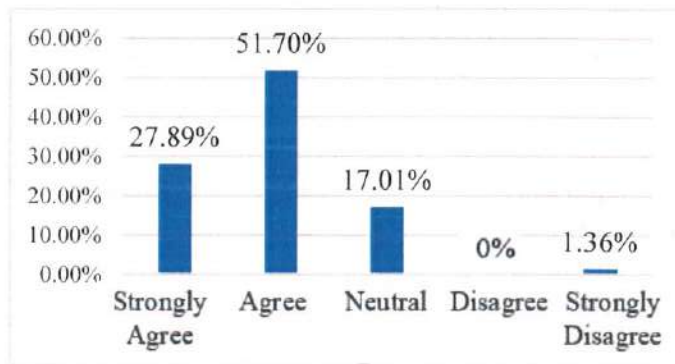

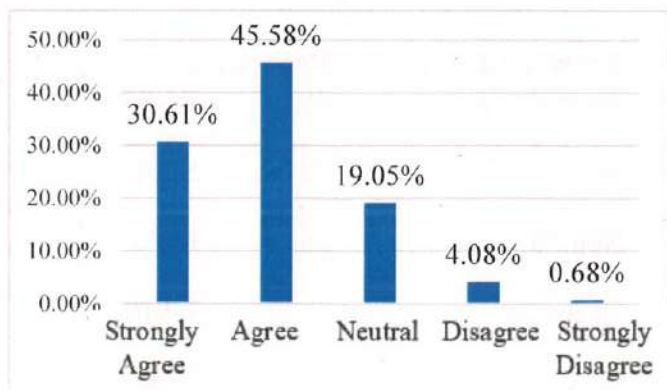

27. MIER College of Education offers diverse exposure & experience to students

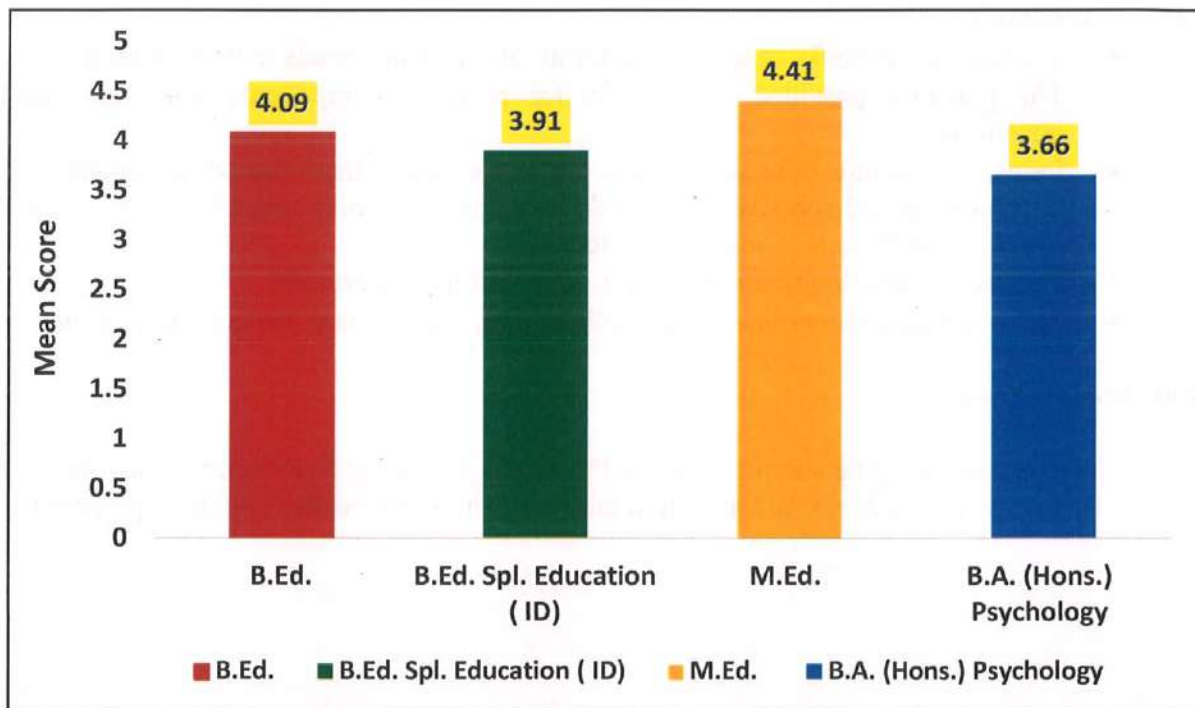

B. Descriptive Analysis

Summary of students' responses- The College has excellent educational technology infrastructure and uses modern ICT tools for teaching, learning and assessment. The faculty of the college is well qualified and experienced. The college organises a number of co-curricular activities, events, guest lectures, orientations, seminars, etc. The college also emphasises the use of student-centric teaching methodologies like experiential learning, problem-solving methods, flipped classrooms, panel discussions etc. The students have acknowledged the college's attempt to develop their personality through communication skills workshops, value-added courses and life skills programmes. The students are highly appreciative of its rigorous practices that inculcate a sense of discipline, focus and dedication among students.

The programme- wise Student Satisfaction Index is given below:



The mean score of B.Ed. programme is 4.09 which denotes that 81.8 percent students are satisfied with the facilities and services being provided by the college. The mean score of B.Ed. Spl (ID) programme is 3.91 which denotes that 78.2 percent students are satisfied with the facilities and services being provided by the college. For the M.Ed. and B.A (Hons) Psychology programmes, the mean scores are 4.41 and 3.66 respectively which denote that 88.2 percent students of M.Ed. programme and 73.2 percent students of B.A (Hons) Psychology programme are satisfied with the facilities and services being provided by the college.

Major Observations/Suggestions and Action Taken:

I. Infrastructure


- The computers in the library need to be updated to the latest operating system.
- There should be a more efficient printing system i.e., students can give print commands through their laptops or mobile phones.
- There should be a well-equipped computer lab in each department to increase productivity and output.
- The canteen services and infrastructure need to be improved. The food served at times is not of good quality and the vendor is not hygiene conscious.
- The number of washrooms is less and they are not always clean.
- Sports and recreational facilities need improvement.

II. Academics

- The number of books in the library for all programmes needs to be increased.
- The guidance provided by teachers for practical components and dissertations needs improvement.
- Industry exposure is lacking. More field/educational trips should be organised. Visits to hospitals, special schools, etc. and field research for more exposure to the related subject should be incorporated into the curriculum.
- The faculty attrition rate is high in the Psychology department.
- There should be an online leave application system through the college website.

Follow-Up Action:

The analysis shall be submitted to the Principal. A meeting shall be convened by the Principal to discuss the feedback and an action taken report of the feedback shall be prepared.


Action Taken Report

A meeting was held by the Principal with the HoDs of SOE and SOSSH, Deputy HoD SOE, Programme Coordinators, SOSSH and the IQAC team to discuss the major observations of the feedback and the suggestions given the by the students. The following action taken report has been prepared on the basis of the decisions taken in the meeting:

S.No.	Major Observations/Suggestions	Action Taken
Infrastructure		
1.	The computers in the library need to be updated to the latest operating system. There should be a more efficient printing system i.e., students can give print commands through their laptops or mobile phones.	Instructions have been given to the ICT department for upgrading the library systems with the latest OS. However, taking printouts through email is already set up through the computers available in the college library for the students. Printouts can be taken with the help of the library assistant. Tracking of printouts and paper usage would not be possible if students give commands from their own devices.
2.	There should be a well-equipped computer lab in each department to increase productivity and output.	Apart from the main computer lab, 5 computers have been provided in the ET Cell and 10 computers in the library for students. The students have been informed to use the computers as and when required. Besides, 45 computers have been made available in the school computer lab which can be used after 1:45 pm.
3.	Canteen services and infrastructure need to be improved. The food served at times is not of good quality and the vendor is not hygiene conscious.	The canteen vendor has been briefed about the poor services. He has been given a time of 1 month to improve the services and food quality failing which the college shall advertise for a new canteen contractor.
4.	Less number of washrooms and a lack of cleanliness.	The cleaning staff have been given instructions to clean the washrooms at least twice a day, especially after the mid-day break in a proper manner.
5.	Sports and recreational facilities need improvement.	The college has provided new sports equipment for the students. The PET has been asked to prepare a proper schedule for sports activities in coordination with the Incharge Sports committee so that ample opportunities for games can be provided to students.

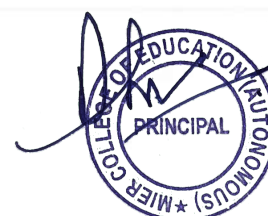
Academics		
6.	The number of books in the library for all programmes needs to be increased.	Instructions have been given to the concerned Heads and faculty of both the SOE and SSSH along with the librarians to prepare a list of books to be purchased to meet the deficiency pointed out by the students.
7.	The guidance provided by teachers for practical components and dissertations needs improvement.	All the teachers concerned with the completion of practical components and dissertation work have been clearly instructed to provide better guidance to the students. They have been asked to provide a specific period in the time table to address the problems of the students. The HoDs have also been asked to supervise these activities in a thorough manner.
8.	Industry exposure is lacking. More field/educational trips should be organised. Visits to hospitals, special schools, etc. and field research for more exposure to the related subject should be incorporated into the curriculum.	The HoDs of the SOE and SSSH have been given instructions to include and conduct field visits and educational trips every semester for the students to give them practical exposure wherever required. These activities shall also be incorporated as part of their sessional work based on the requirements of the curriculum.
9.	The faculty attrition rate is high in the Psychology department.	The college has been able to appoint new teachers in a timely manner to ensure that the academic work is not hampered, and the curriculum is completed on time. Efforts have been made to retain teachers throughout the session and minimize gaps in teaching.
10.	There should be an online leave application system through the college website.	The mobile app linked to the new ERP is being made active by the end of September and the students shall be able to apply for their leaves online.
