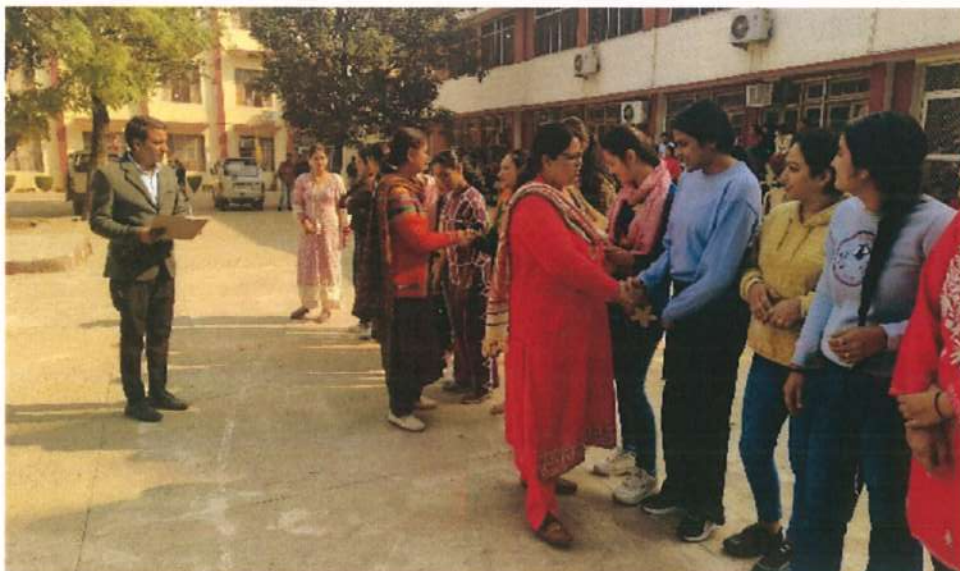
### Report

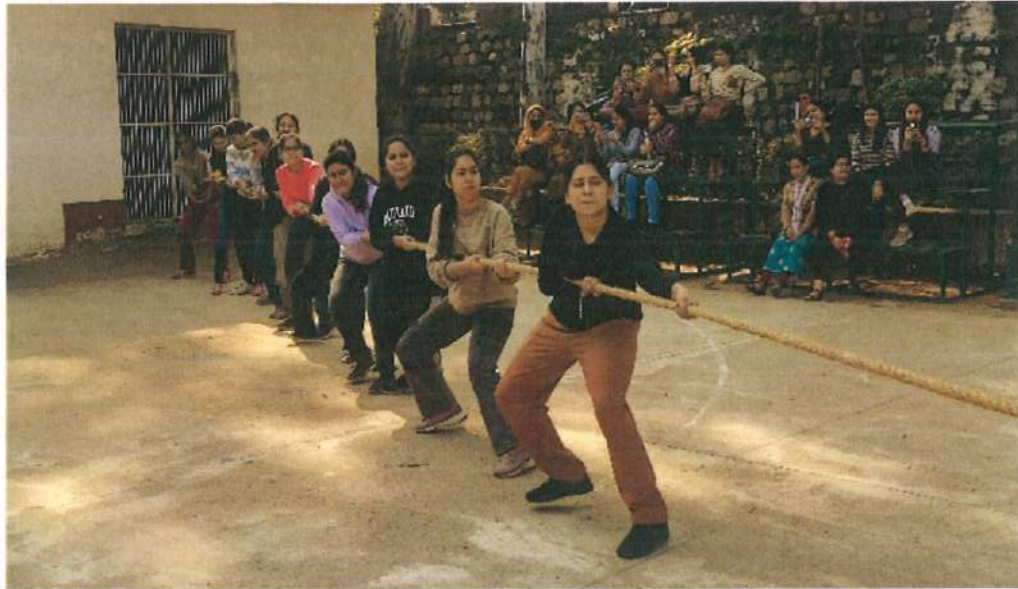
