INTRODUCTION: The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is a vital part of the institution's quality assurance system and has been continuously working towards ensuring quality enhancement and sustenance. Collection and analysis of feedback from all the students on quality-related institutional processes helps to provide valuable insights and guides us to serve our students and to improve the educational experience for our current and future students. This report focuses on the analysis of the feedback of students on the curriculum.

DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS: An online feedback form was created and shared with the students of the School of Social Sciences and Humanities (SSSH), batch 2022-26 through Performance Insight-360 (PI-360), Quality Analytics Framework. To arrive at comprehensive results, percentages have been calculated. For the effective presentation of the data tables graphs have been used. Questions were based on a Likert scale which was rated as 1: Strongly Agree 2: Agree 3: Neutral 4: Disagree 5: Strongly Disagree



Descriptive Feedback

While 57.14% of the students are overall satisfied, 42.86% are not satisfied, which indicates a need for addressing underlying issues to improve the overall satisfaction. A t majority (92.86%) of students believe that the pace of the curriculum is appropriate. A significant 85.71% of students agree that teaching and assessment methods (tests, projects, internships, technology usage etc.) align with the curriculum, suggesting a strong integration between instructional strategies and curriculum goals. While 64.29% of the students feel supported by the teaching methods, 35.72% do not. Therefore, teaching approaches need to be further improved. The feedback suggests that while the majority of students are satisfied with various aspects of the curriculum, there are significant areas for improvement. Enhancing the understanding and clarity of learning outcomes, increasing relevance and interest, supporting diverse learning styles and better alignment with future goals and employability are key areas that need to be addressed.

Major Observations/Suggestions given by students:

- 1. Workshops for Career Development and Life Skills-
 - There is a need to organize workshops on career development and life skills. This will address issues or concerns of the students related to skills development and employability.
- 2. Integration of different teaching methodologies, updating of library resources, and re-orientation regarding PLOs and CLOs-
 - There is a need to integrate diverse teaching approaches/methodologies and instructional strategies, update the library's collection of books, and reorient students regarding the Course Learning Outcomes (CLOs) and Programme Learning Outcomes (PLOs).



Descriptive Feedback

A significant majority (71.11%) of students agree that the learning outcomes are well-defined, which indicates clarity in the educational objectives. However, 28.88% remain neutral or disagree, which suggests a scope for improvement in communicating these outcomes more effectively. 82.22% of the students agree that the academic load is well-distributed. While 66.67% of students agree that the curriculum encourages practical application and skill development, 33.33% of the students are neutral or disagree. This indicates that the practical component of the curriculum should be enhanced. The students have also advocated for additional educational trips and practical exposure to enrich their learning. The feedback indicates that the B.A. (Hons.) Psychology curriculum is well-received by students, with high levels of satisfaction in many areas. By addressing the areas of concern as highlighted above, the college can further enhance the educational experience for its students.

Major Observations/Suggestions given by students:

1. Educational Trips and Practical Exposure:

- More educational trips and practical workshops related to psychology would enhance students' understanding and application of theoretical concepts.
- Incorporating field trips to psychiatry hospitals and other relevant institutions could provide practical exposure.

2. Curriculum Enhancement:

• Suggestions for incorporating more practical knowledge into the curriculum are highlighted, including digital assignments and internships.

3. Infrastructure and Resources:

• Improvement in infrastructure and access to resources, such as upgrading books in the library has been suggested by the students.





Descriptive Feedback

The students have expressed high overall satisfaction (81.25%), though 18.75% are neutral, which highlights areas for continuous improvement. The majority (79.17%) of the students agree that teaching and assessment methods align with the curriculum. While 62.5% of students agree that the curriculum encourages practical application and skill development, 37.5% are neutral or disagree. This indicates that the practical components within the curriculum need to be further improved. The feedback reveals a generally positive perception of the Political Science curriculum, with significant strengths being well-defined outcomes, relevant topics, and overall satisfaction. Key areas for improvement include developing critical thinking, practical application and use of diverse teaching-learning strategies. Addressing these aspects can further raise the curriculum's effectiveness and student satisfaction.

Major Observations/Suggestions given by students:

1. Enhancing Curriculum Relevance:

- a. The students have proposed the incorporation of orientations, guest lectures, visits and exploratory activities to study Political Science from its foundational roots, suggesting a more engaging approach to curriculum delivery.
- b. The students have expressed satisfaction with the curriculum's alignment with future career goals and employability prospects, however, concerns regarding student support in terms of career counselling and future career prospects need to be addressed.

Follow-Up Action:

The analysis shall be submitted to the Principal. A meeting shall be convened by the Principal to discuss the feedback and an action taken report of the feedback shall be prepared.

Action Taken Report

A meeting was held by the Principal with the HoD of SSSH, COE, Programme Coordinators and the IQAC team to discuss the significant observations of the feedback and the suggestions the students gave. The following action taken report has been prepared based on the decisions taken in the meeting:

Observation/Suggestion	Action Taken
Workshop for Career Development and Life Skills	The college has organized workshops on personality development and life skills for the students. Career counseling services are being expanded. Workshops on career counselling, resume building and interview skills have been planned for the students.
Integration of new Teaching Methodologies	The college has Implemented diverse teaching methodologies namely- Flipped Classroom: Students review lecture materials at home and engage in interactive activities in class, Blended Learning: the faculty combined online digital media with traditional classroom methods to provide a more flexible learning experience, Collaborative Learning: Students work in groups to solve problems, complete tasks, and discuss topics, Guest Lectures and Industry Experts: Regular sessions by industry experts and guest lectures were conducted to provide practical insights, Use of Educational Technology: The faculty integrated tools like online quizzes, discussion forums, etc. to enhance learning.
There is need to update the library's collection of books	The library's collection has been significantly enhanced with the addition of 69 new books, spanning various courses across the SSSH programs of study.
