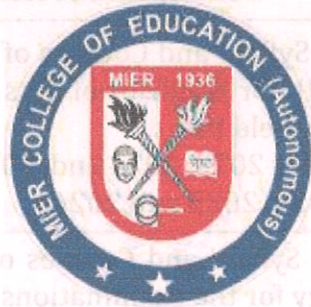

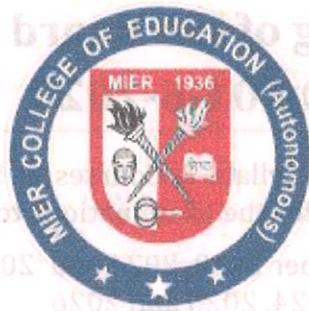

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SCHEME OF TWO -YEAR M. Ed. PROGRAMME (CBCS)
