**GUEST LECTURE ON 'NEW EDUCATION POLICY 2020- THE FUTURE OF  
TEACHER EDUCATION' On 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2021**

A guest lecture was organized by the Co-Curricular Committee of MIER College on the theme 'New Education Policy 2020-The Future of Teacher Education'. Prof. Rajeev Rattan Sharma, Head PG Department of Education, University of Jammu was the Resource person. Dr. Adit Gupta, Principal MIER College of Education chaired the lecture. Dr Mool Raj Sharma HoD PG Department, Dr. Rohinka Sharma HoD UG Department along with the faculty members and the students of both PG and UG Department of semester first attended the event.

Dr. Adit Gupta, Principal MIER College of Education extended a warm welcome to the resource person and the audience. He introduced him as an expert in Teacher Education, Comparative Education, Sociological and Philosophical Perspectives on Education. He further said that Prof. Rattan is a distinguished researcher and a teacher educator, who has published his work and presented both at national and international conferences. Additionally, he has guided many research scholars at MPhil and PhD levels and undertook state and nation level projects in addition to organizing workshops and conferences. He has held many administrative positions at different levels and has many accolades to his credit.

Speaking on the occasion, Prof. Rajeev Rattan Sharma emphasized on the need of change and transformation of education such as to achieve the goals of sustainable development, improve learning outcomes and cognitive skills of students, minimize fragmentation in higher education and rigid separation of different disciplines. He also comprehensively explained the relevance of bringing this change and transformation in education. Prof Rattan provided an overview of the policy and specifically elaborated on teacher and teacher education be it the shifting of teacher education from school education arena to higher education or the structure of teacher education or the preparation of teachers for

different levels namely foundational, middle and secondary. He also deliberated on the transformation of teacher preparation institutes into multidisciplinary institutes, curriculum for teacher preparation, mentorship and different programs from one-year to four-years. Prof Rattan highlighted various future challenges such as implementing single national test by NTA, accreditation, public-private partnership, etc.

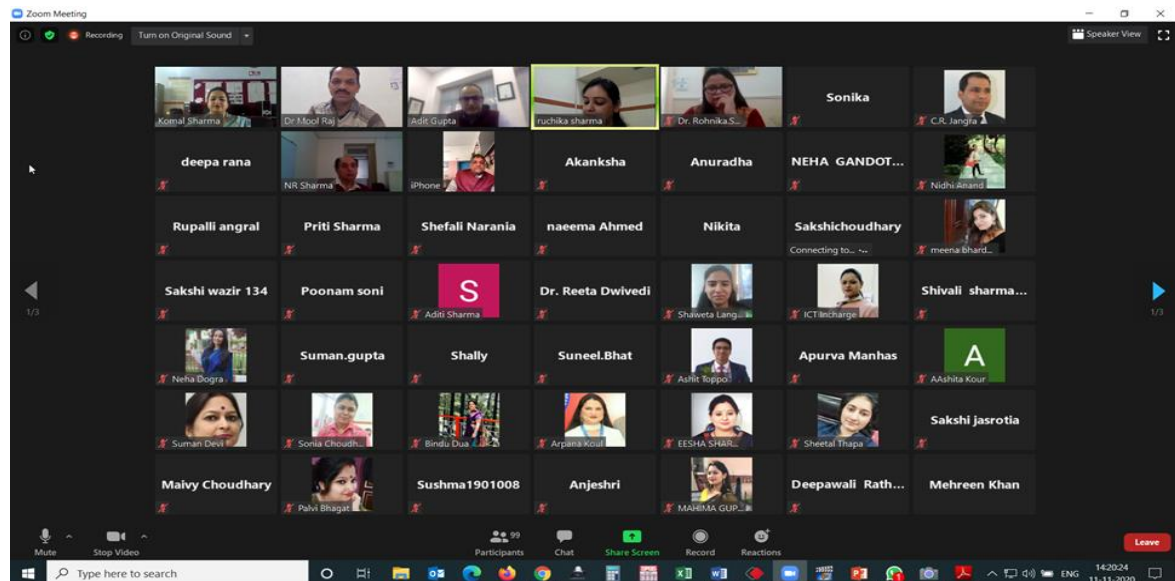
### **Panel Discussion "New Education Policy 2020- A paradigm Shift for Higher Education" on 11<sup>th</sup> November,2021**



## Webinar on ‘Various Errors in Educational Research’ organized on 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2020

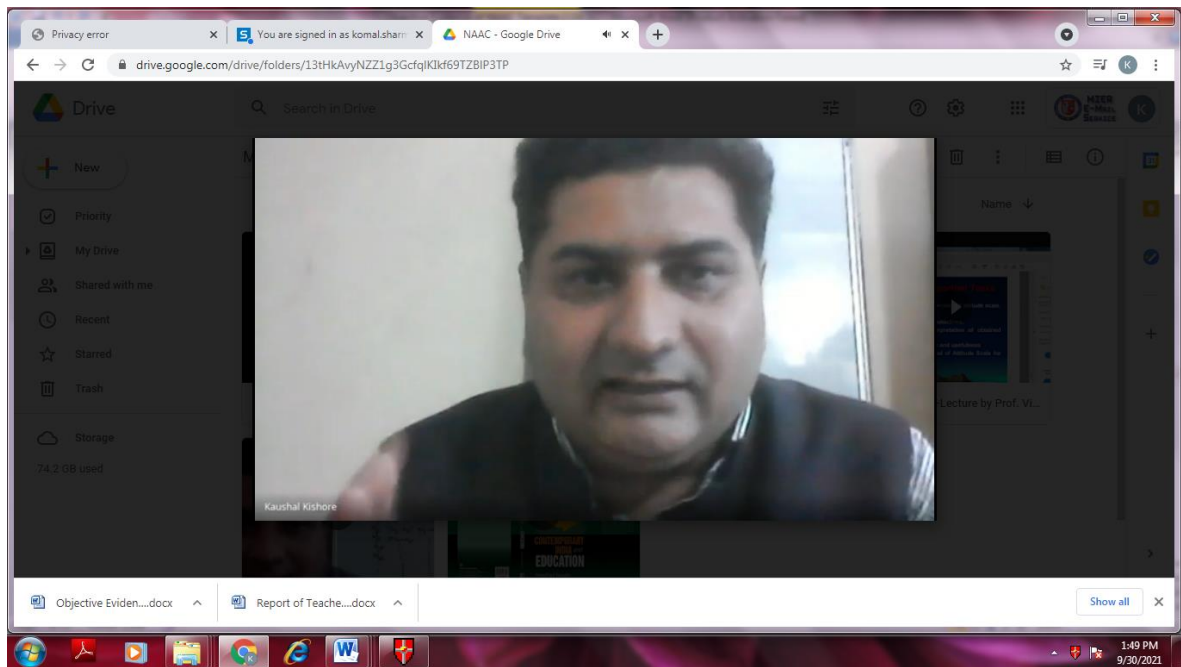
A guest lecture on the theme “Various Errors in Educational Research” was organised by the Centre for Educational Research. The resource person was Prof. Kaushal Kishore, Dean and Head School of Education, Central University of South Bihar, Gaya. Prof. Adit Gupta, Principal MIER College of Education extended a warm welcome to the resource person and introduced him as an expert in the field of Educational Research, Teacher Education and Emerging Educational Trends. In his lecture, Dr. Kishore comprehensively explained four different types of errors namely standard error of measurement, standard error of difference, Type 1 error in hypothesis testing, and Type II error in hypothesis testing. He opened his deliberation explaining the Central Limit Theorem as a statistical theory to relate with the topic and ease of understanding by the students. Prof. Kishore provided ample examples explaining the various errors in research and stressed on the importance of understanding their nature. At the end, he discussed framing of the hypothesis whether it is directional or non-directional and added it depends on the analysis of the review of the literature. This was followed by an interactive session where the faculty members and students clarified their doubts and queries.

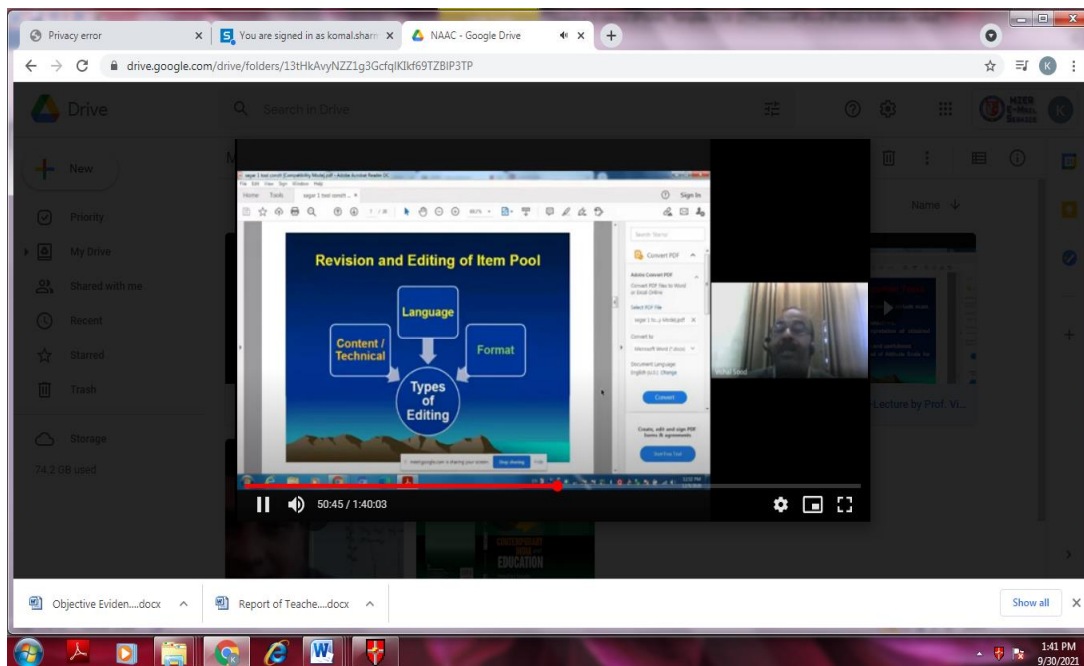
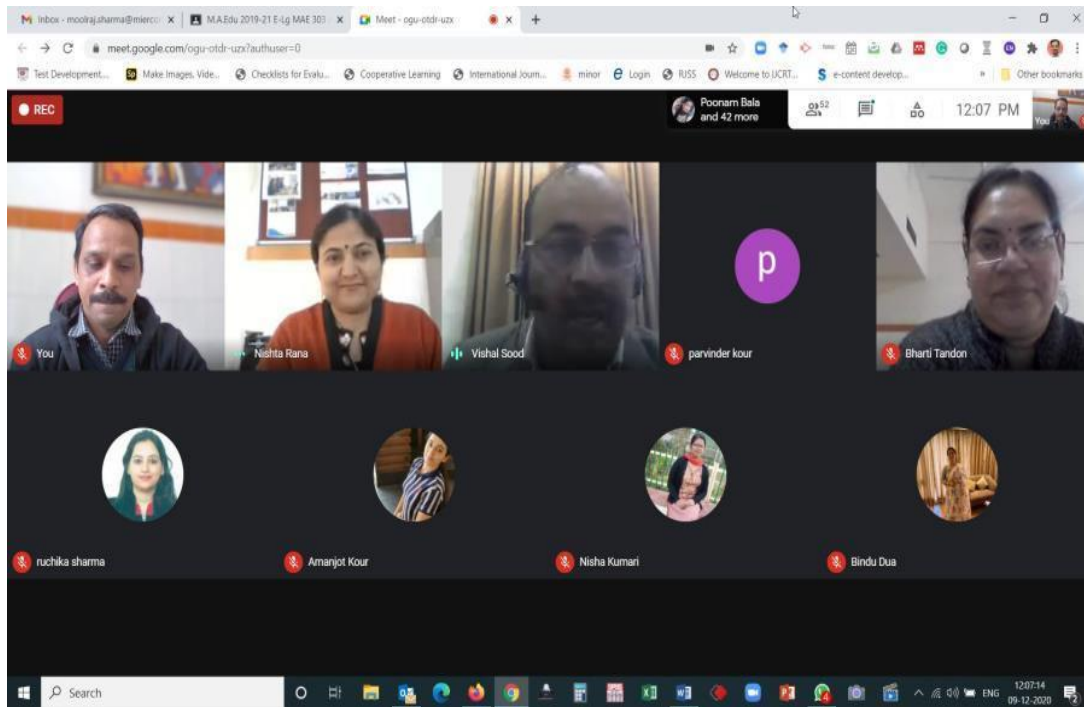

### **Webinar on ‘Development of Attitude Scale on 9<sup>th</sup> December,2020**

The Center for Educational Research (CER) organized a guest lecture on the theme “Development of an Attitude Scale”. The resource person was Prof. Vishal Sood, Dean and Head, School of Education, Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Dharamshala and an expert in the field of Psychometry, Research Methodology, Statistical Data analysis and Educational Measurement and Evaluation. In his lecture, Dr. Sood said research tool construction in social sciences is different from positive sciences or pure sciences as in social sciences the focus is on assessing behaviour which is dynamic in nature. He opened his deliberation explaining the classification of research instrument based on the nature of the behaviour characteristics, purpose of research instrument, use of the research tool and types of items in the instrument. Furthermore, he emphasized that there are some essentials that a researcher has to keep in mind while framing the research tool which include: domain of the study, reviewing theoretical and empirical research, identifying the areas and subareas, preparing the item pool, considering the nature of the population and availability of time, resources, and material.

New Colombo Plan objectives:

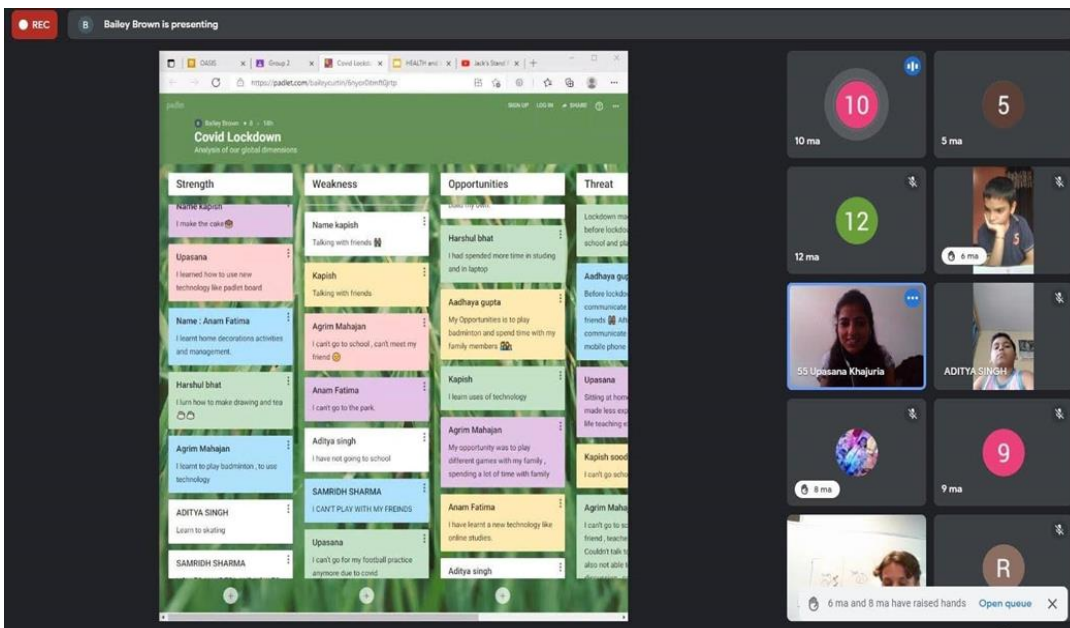
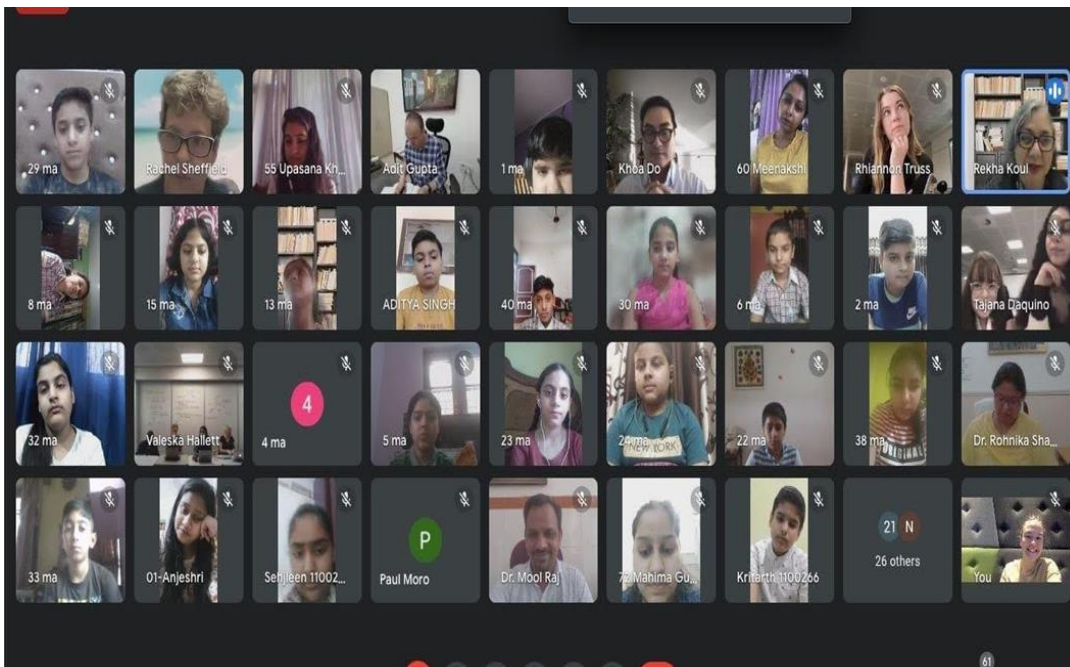
- To offer Australian and Indian pre service teachers a hand on teaching opportunity that aims at leaving them adaptable and confident in any teaching environment.
- To develop the sense of problem based learning among the pre service teacher and students.
- To focus on the UNSDG, sustainable development goals.

The New Colombo Plan 2021, between Curtin University and MIER College of education was conducted over online platforms through google classrooms and google meet where the pre service teacher of Australia and India collaborated to work on. The Pre Service teachers were provided with tabs to work on. Through this exchange program they learned various technological techniques which can be used by them in the local working classrooms. The Students from Model Academy Jammu were involved and divided into different google classrooms which included one pre service teacher from India and Australia respectively, together they worked on the UN Sustainable Developmental Goal (UNSDG) and selected one as their "BIG QUESTION" and worked on it through the methodology of Problem Based Learning.
