

Faculty Benchmarking Policy

1. PURPOSE

The faculty benchmarking policy aims to establish standards that will help identify faculty who are exceeding expectations and deserve faculty recognition and awards. It will also assist in identifying staff members who might need assistance in particular areas of their academic work and professional careers.

2. SCOPE

This policy applies to the faculty of the School of Education and the School of Social Sciences and Humanities.

3. DEFINITIONS

- a. Benchmark: A benchmark is a target level of performance for a given KPI or a quantitative measure.
- b. Benchmarking: refers to the process of comparing and reviewing the performances of the faculty against the set criteria/standards.
- c. Key Performance Indicators (KPIs): A key performance is a quantifiable indicator of the progress of the faculty towards an intended outcome.
- d. KPI Analysis: refers to a comparison and contrast of benchmarks to determine strengths and areas for improvement.

4. PRINCIPLES

- a. The benchmarking criteria for establishing standards shall be aligned with the vision, mission, values, and strategic plan of the College.
- b. The benchmarking criteria, standards and process shall be defined before the commencement of the actual benchmarking exercise.
- c. The benchmark targets shall be set for each of the key performance areas to measure actual performance against the set targets.



5. KEY PERFORMANCE AREAS

The performance of the faculty shall be measured on the following Key Performance areas:

- 1. Academics (Teaching & Evaluation)
- 2. Research Output
- 3. Professional Development
- 4. Achievements

6. PROCESS

A. Collation of the Data

i. Academics (Teaching and Evaluation)

Teaching

- The academic audits shall be done to assess the teaching performance of the faculty members of the college on different parameters by using an Academic Audit Form.
- The final score obtained by each faculty during these audits shall be analysed against the set benchmark.

Evaluation

The result of different programmes shall be uploaded and analysed in PI 360 against the set benchmark.

ii. Research, Professional Development and Achievements

Each faculty shall upload their respective data under the above categories in PI360 and their performance shall be analysed against the set benchmark by the management.

B. Analysis of the Data

The data uploaded under different key performance areas shall be analysed through PI360 to evaluate the performance of faculty as per the indices set in the software.

The final score sheet shall be prepared by the IQAC and submitted to the management. The faculty member with the highest score shall be adjudged as the 'Best Teacher' for the session.
