

The event, held on 6th December 2023, was designed with a primary focus on spreading awareness about AIDS, emphasizing prevention measures, and combating the stigma associated with the disease. A group of about 26 student members of the unit, along with their In-charge Mrs. Suman Devi, visited the village.

Dr. Adit Gupta, principal, MIER appreciated the efforts of the Units in conducting such pertinent activities for the community.

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



Mr. Rahil explained various modes of digital transactions and the use of different mobile apps like Googal Pay, PAYTM, UPI, E Wallet, E banking etc . Additionally, He claimed that with the launch of UPI transactions, digital payments in India had made a significant advancement. However, he cautioned that scammers quickly adjusted and developed several strategies to trick customers, created forged virtual payment addresses for refunds, disaster support, etc. as well as false cash back offers and OR codes to deceive collect requests. He said there is no doubt that fraudsters are getting trickier with each passing day, but we must take precautions and security measures.

Ms. Alisha Vaid, student of 2nd semester, also explained the use of generic medicines. She said before purchasing the medicine, one should check the manufacturing and expiry date as well.







Report on the events during observance of Swachh Bharat Summer Internship -2019
