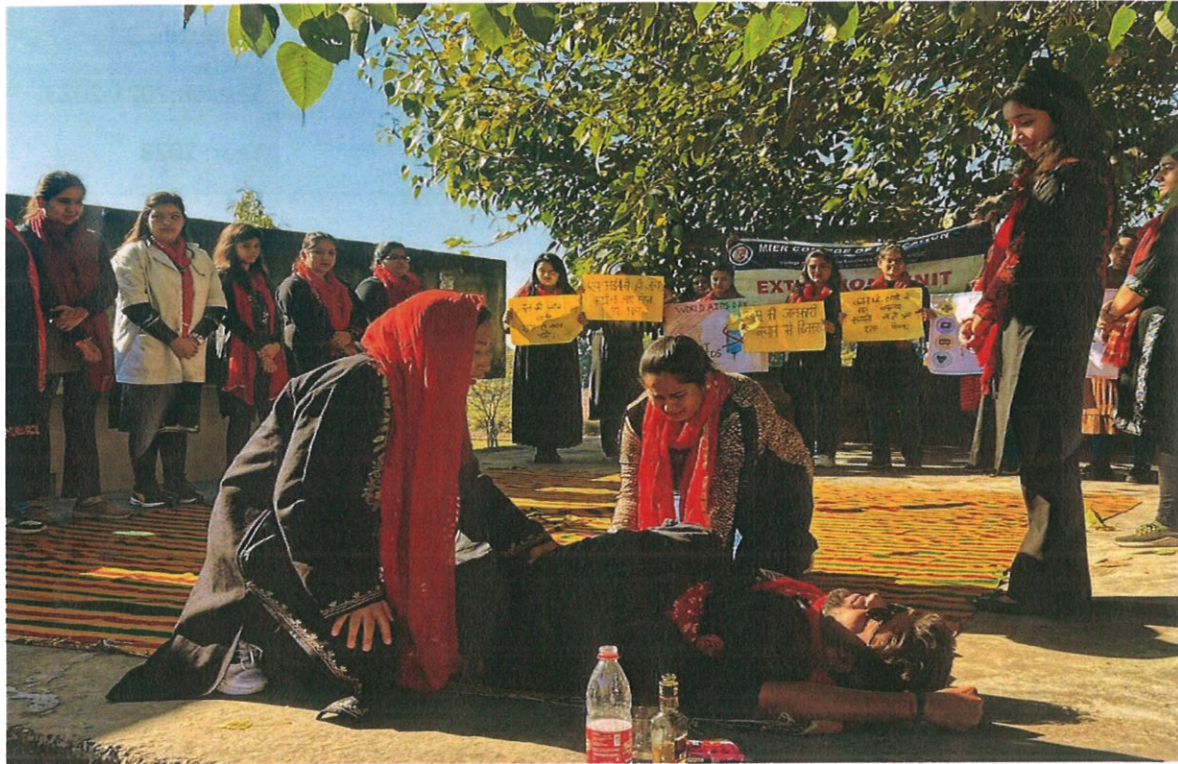

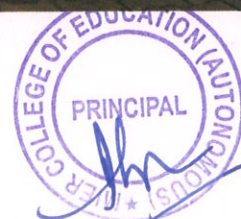

Mrs. Suman Devi In-charge Extension unit, extended a warm welcome to the resource person. Mr. Rahil Gupta Bank Manager, Punjab National Bank, MIER Branch was the resource person.

Mr. Rahil explained various modes of digital transactions and the use of different mobile apps like Googal Pay, PAYTM, UPI, E Wallet, E banking etc . Additionally, He claimed that with the launch of UPI transactions, digital payments in India had made a significant advancement. However, he cautioned that scammers quickly adjusted and developed several strategies to trick customers, created forged virtual payment addresses for refunds, disaster support, etc. as well as false cash back offers and QR codes to deceive collect requests. He said there is no doubt that fraudsters are getting trickier with each passing day, but we must take precautions and security measures.

Report on the events during observance of Swachh Bharat Summer Internship -2019


